**NOTICE OF PERMIT HEARING OF THE  
CLEARWATER UNDERGROUND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors for the Clearwater Underground Water Conservation District will conduct a hearing on the Applications for Permit as described below at 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday May 14, 2013 in the Clearwater UWCD Main Office located at 700 Kennedy Court, Belton, Texas in compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

The Application for a Combination Drilling and Operating Permit and the requested exception to District Rule 11.5-Spacing Requirements, if granted, would authorize the permit holders (Linda & Mike Fletcher) to drill and/or operate a well, and will be located within 6 feet of the north property line and 33 feet of the west property line, both being adjacent of the Belton Lake frontage owned/managed by the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers and in the Clearwater Underground Water Conservation District according to the terms and conditions set forth in the permit.

The second application, if granted, would authorize the permit holder Jack Hillard Dozer Service & Materials LP to only drill a well within Clearwater Underground Water Conservation according to the terms and conditions set forth in the permit. The drilling permit will not provide an operating permit at this time.



A person wishing to submit a Contested Case Hearing Request who is unable to appear at the hearing on the date and time set forth above must also file a motion for continuance with CUWCD demonstrating good cause for the inability to appear.
