Workshop convened with President, Leland Gersbach, at 1:32 p.m.

Workshop Item #1. Receive report from District Staff concerning the 85th Legislative Session.

Dirk presented an update on the 85th Legislative Session. He commented that he receives tracking reports on Bills from TAGD and a condensed version from Ty Embry weekly and passes those on to the Board. Dirk highlighted Bills affecting Groundwater Districts.

Dirk Aaron, Judy Parker, David Cole, Tim Brown, Bill Schumann, and David Leigh Jr. attended the SAWRA committee meeting in Austin, Monday, April 10th. Dirk and David Cole testified against the Bill on behalf of the District. Dirk briefed the Board on the sequence of events.

Workshop Item #2. Discuss proposed Trinity monitor well at James Construction site.

Dirk presented information on proposed Middle Trinity monitor well at James Construction. The well was used for the Batch Plant at James Construction. The Batch Plant is no longer being used. The property is leased from the CJ Evans Limited Partnership.

James Construction has 3 options for this well: 1) case/cap; 2) plug the well; or 3) contract for a monitor well with landowner at the District's expense to case the well.

Property owner is amenable to the idea of allowing the District to use the well for monitoring at the District's expense. Tommy Lovelace bid \$16,109 to case and equip as a monitor well.

Workshop Item #3. Discuss 2017 Texas Groundwater Summit August 29-31.

The Texas Groundwater Summit will be held August 29-31 in San Marcos. Early Bird registration ends May 15th. Board members were asked to let Shelly know if they will be attending at the May Board meeting so she can secure hotel rooms and discounted registration fees.

<u>Workshop Item #4.</u> Discuss the status and timeline for final determination of Desired Future Conditions and Explanatory Report to occur for the DFC determination by GMA8 per TWC section 36.108.

Dirk explained that he and Judy are waiting for notification that the Explanatory Report is administratively complete. TWDB expects this to happen in June or July. Dirk and Judy will keep everyone posted.
