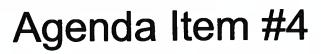

Narrative:

The CUWCD Staff requests line item budget amendments for the purpose of:

- 1. Adjusting line item 53703 (Legal Rules/Accountability) to cover legal expenses accrued during the Covid-19 pandemic related to the Attorney General's suspension of Texas Open Meeting Act teleconference statutes and protocol for virtual meetings
- 2. Additional adjustment to line item 53703 (Legal Rules/Accountability) in anticipation of additional expenses for the remainder of FY20.
- 3. Adjust line item 53702 (Legal Endangered Species) in anticipation of legal fees related endangered species.
- 4. Adjusting line item 53120 (Endangered Species Coalition) in anticipation of additional fees associated with continued studies and investigation.

General Manager suggests forgoing new monitor well construction for the remainder of the year and utilizing those funds to cover the requested budget amendments. Line item 53702 (Monitor Well Construction) is currently sitting at \$70,000.

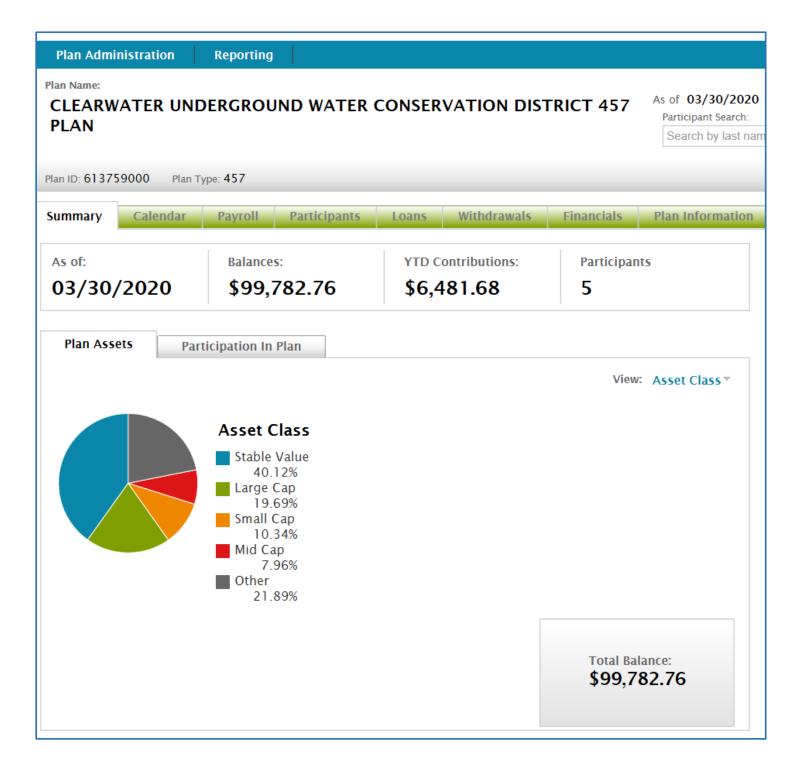
